(a) Offer to pay or rebate all or any portion of an insurance deductible or claims proceeds as an inducement to the sale of goods or services related to a residential roof contract;

(b) Grant an allowance or discount against the fee to be charged under the contract; or

(c) Pay the owner of residential real estate for whom services have been performed pursuant to Sections

1 to 5 of this Act, for any reason, any form of compensation in excess of one hundred dollars (\$100) including but not limited to a:

1. Bonus;

2. Coupon;

3. Credit;

4. Gift;

5. Prize;

6. Referral fee; or

7. Any other item having a monetary value.

HOUSE ENROLLED ACT No. 1237

SECTION 8. IC 24-5-11-10.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012]:

Sec. 10.5. (a) A home improvement supplier shall not advertise, offer, or promise to pay or rebate any part of an insurance deductible to induce a person to enter into a home improvement contract or otherwise purchase goods or services from the home improvement supplier. Acts prohibited by this subsection include the following:

(1) Advertising, offering, or promising to grant an allowance or a discount against the home improvement contract price or against other fees or charges.

(2) Advertising, offering, or promising to pay to an insured consumer, or to any other person, any form of compensation, including a gift, prize, bonus, coupon, credit, referral fee, or other item of monetary value for any reason, including the display of a sign or advertisement on residential on residential property.
